

## A 'what to do guide' to Coronavirus related absences for parents of children using Greenway Women's Centre Childcare Services

What do I do if....	Action required:	Return to Greenway when...
My child has Coronavirus symptoms:	<b>DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY</b> Self isolate. Get a test* and inform Greenway immediately about the results.	The test comes back negative and your child has been free from fever for 48hrs.
My child tests positive for Coronavirus:	<b>DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY</b> Inform Greenway immediately about the results. Self isolate for at least 10 days.	Your child can return after <b>10 days</b> of self-isolation.
Somebody in my child's household has Coronavirus symptoms:	<b>DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY for 14 days</b> Household member should take a test* and inform Greenway immediately about the results.	Your child has stayed at home for 14 days after the first person in the home started having symptoms.
Somebody in my child's household has tested positive with Coronavirus:	<b>DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY</b> Inform Greenway immediately about the results.	Your child has completed 14 days of self-isolation.
Track and Trace has identified my child as a close contact of someone with symptoms of confirmed Coronavirus:	<b>DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY</b> Self isolate for 14 days.	Your child has completed 14 days of self-isolation.
My child has travelled abroad and has to self-isolate as part of the quarantine process:	<b>DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY for 14 days</b>	Your child has completed 14 days of quarantine.
Staff or a child/children in my child's bubble have tested positive:	<b>DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY</b> Everyone in the bubble must self-isolate and take a test*.	When a negative test is confirmed or when the necessary isolation period is completed.
