

A 'what to do guide' to Covid-19 (Coronavirus)

What do I do if...	Action required	Return to Greenway when...
My child has Covid 19 symptoms	DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY Self-isolate Get a test and inform Greenway immediately with results	It is advised that parents should get their children tested. This will then allow us to inform any close contacts and carry out the isolation period. If they do not want to get their child tested we would ask that the child carries out 10 days of isolation before they can return to setting. In regards to children who have symptoms of coronavirus and a negative test, these children need to stay at home until they have had a normal temperature for 2 days, <u>unless they have been assessed physically or remotely by a GP and the GP has advised that :</u> A) the individual is not believed to have COVID-19 or any other infection that could be transmitted in the setting; and B)) that the individual can return to the childcare setting. In this case the provider may decide whether or not to admit the child in advance of the child having had a normal temperature for 2 days. (Tests can be booked online at Gov.uk)
My child tests positive for Covid 19	DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY Inform Greenway immediately with results Self-isolate for at least 10 days	They can return after 10 days of self-isolation (from the first day they developed symptoms).
Somebody in my household has Covid 19 symptoms	Household member should take a test and inform Greenway immediately with results CHILD SHOULD NOT COME TO GREENWAY UNTIL HOUSEHOLD MEMBER RECEIVES RESULT	If the test is positive the child would be deemed a close contact and should stay at home and self-isolate for 10 days. If the test is negative the child can return to Greenway.
Somebody in my household has tested positive with Covid 19	DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY Inform Greenway immediately with results	The child has completed 10 days of self-isolation.
Track and track has identified my child as a close contact of someone with symptoms of confirmed Covid 19. I have identified that my child had close contact with the confirmed case 2 days before the first day of symptoms to 10 days after.	DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY Keep Greenway up to date e.g. if your child has remained free from symptoms during isolation period Self-isolate for 10 day	The child has completed 10 days of self-isolation.
My child has travelled abroad and has to self-isolate as part of the quarantine process	DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY for 10 days	The child has completed 10 days of quarantine.
Staff or children in my child's group have tested positive	DO NOT COME TO GREENWAY Anyone in the group who has been deemed a 'close contact' must self-isolate	When they have complete 10 days of isolation. If, during isolation, they develop symptoms they should be tested. If results are positive they will have to inform Greenway and isolate for 10 days.
